Maker Daytona Beach Draws crowd to Launch, Expands “Show N’ Tell” Nights Across Volusia County

April 30, 2026 Daytona Beach, FL — Maker Daytona Beach, an extension of Maker Faire Orlando, is expanding its **Show N’ Tell Night series** across Volusia County following a strong debut in DeLand that drew more than 60 attendees.

The community-driven series will now take place **every second Thursday of the month through August 2026**, with upcoming events hosted at Cinematique Theater, Daytona Beach Regional Library, Deltona Regional Library, and The Gallery at TikTok.

Designed as an interactive alternative to traditional presentations, Show N’ Tell Nights invite participants to bring and share projects they’ve built, from robotics and engineering prototypes to crafts and creative builds, while attendees engage directly with the makers behind them.

“People bring what they’ve built, and the community gets to experience it up close. That’s where real learning happens.” said Valerie Uy, organizer of Maker Daytona Beach

The upcoming lineup reflects growing momentum in the region’s maker ecosystem, featuring **Bethune-Cookman robotics and engineering students, local craft makers, LEGO builders, and emerging creators of all ages.**

This initiative is part of a broader effort to strengthen connections between education, industry, and community, while building toward a larger hands-on exhibition planned for late spring 2027.

Maker Daytona Beach is actively partnering with organizations such as Volusia County Schools STEM and The Brown/ Museum of Arts & Sciences (MOAS) to expand access to hands-on, project-based learning opportunities.
